Many venues have water bubblers so you can keep hydrated for free throughout your day at the cricket.



You can pack your own food and even your own sealed unopened drinks, for your day at the cricket (just leave the alcohol, glass, and cans at home).



You can enjoy your day at the cricket however you choose, with dry zones, family zones, and fan zones available at venues throughout the season.



The KFC T20 INTL matches are all double headers, with the three time ICC World T20 Champions the Commonwealth Bank Southern Stars taking on the Indian Women's Team.



Entry level prices are either the same price or cheaper than last year for International matches this season, and you can get the best price by pre-purchasing online rather than at the gate.

The first Test match at The Gabba was played between Australia and South Africa between 27 November and 3 December 1931.

Between 1993 and 2005, The Gabba was redeveloped in six stages and the seating capacity of the ground is now 42,000.

Venue Information

Transport

Public Transport: For information about public transport to and from The Gabba, please go to: **thegabba.com.au**

Free Public Transport: Match tickets provide free travel to and from all International cricket matches on the Brisbane Transport bus network and the Queensland Rail network (bounded by Nambour, Shorncliffe, Ferny Grove, Cleveland, Varsity Lakes and Rosewood). Note: CityCats and ferries are not included. Ticketholders need to present their ticket in order to travel for free.

Family Information

MILO Family Zone: The MILO Family Zone is located in Section 35-37 in the Western Stand

Baby Change Facilities: Parents Rooms are located near Sections 4, 32, 75 and Gate 9

Lost Children: Lost children will be taken to the closest Match Office, located at Gates 2, 4, 7 and 9.

Prams / Strollers: Prams and strollers can be stored at any of the Match Offices located at Gates 2, 4, 7, 9.

Reflection Room

The Gabba has a reflection room. This is located adjacent to Section 14.

Smoke-Free

The Gabba is a smoke free zone. Patrons who wish to smoke are required to exit the stadium to do so. Smoking is not permitted within 4 metres of any entry or exit point to the stadium.

ATMs/Cash Out

ATMs are located on the Lower Level, Section 4, 12, 21 and 39; and Upper Level, Sections 61 & 73. Tap and go available at food and beverage outlets.

Lost Property

Collectable from Match Offices located at Gates 2, 4, 7, and 9 during the match. Items will then be available for collection from Gate 7 Reception 30 minutes after the match.

First Aid

First Aid is located next to Gate 2, 4, 7 and 9; and in between Section 2-3.

What Can't I Bring In?

The following items will not be permitted into the venue:

Bag & Esky Restrictions

Oversized items will be not be permitted into the venue; that is items which are unable to fit under your seat. Backpacks, baby bags, ladies handbags and gentleman's satchels will be permitted into the venue.

Bags permissible into the venue must meet the following conditions:

- > Maximum bag height 40 cm
- > Maximum bag width 40 cm
- > Maximum bag depth 40 cm
- > Pliable nature (soft to touch)

Bags that do not meet these requirements must be cloaked at the match offices at Gates 2, 4, 7, 9.







Other Restricted Items:

- > Crockery
- > Cans
- > Unsealed bottles (including Thermos)
- > Glass containers
- > Dangerous or illegal substances
- > Flares
- > Fireworks
- > Laser pointers
- > Flags or signs that display political messages
- > Flags or Banners that cover existing venue signage or annoy other guests
- > Flag poles greater than 1.5 m in length and 2 cm in diameter are not permitted into the venue
- > Any item (including clothes) that display offensive messages
- > Potential weapons as determined by security and police e.g., knives, chains, studded belts
- Any item that could be used as a projectile or could create litter - e.g., pizza cartons, streamers, confetti, ticker-tape
- Any item, which in the opinion of Management, has the potential to cause injury or harm to another patron
- Any items, which in the opinion of Management, has the potential to cause damage to the stadium and its facilities
- > Any item that is deemed oversized, and therefore could not fit under the patrons seat

Security staff may inform the QLD Police if on site of the presence of certain prohibited items (e.g. such as weapons and other dangerous goods) and may seek support from Police officers in dealing with the items and the spectators intending to bring them into the Stadium.

Sun Affected Seats

Please be aware that certain areas within the Northern Stand lower deck and the Southern Stand receive direct sun at varying times during the day. The Eastern (lower, mid and upper) Stand is also sun-affected on occasions. Patrons are advised to wear sunscreen even when seated in a shaded area.

Accessible Tickets / Disabled Access

Contact Ticketmaster if you have wheelchair or special needs seating requirements.

Catering Available

There is a variety of food available at The Gabba. This includes 33 food and beverage outlets including cafes and 37 fixed bar outlets.

Pass Outs

Patrons are permitted to leave and re-enter the match however they will need to have their ticket barcode scanned prior to exiting the stadium and have it re-scanned upon entry back into the ground.

- Inflatable items including beach balls, balloons and a receptacle device or structure;
- The use of photographic, video or audio equipment for commercial purposes is not permitted within Adelaide Oval;
- > Professional standard still / video cameras and recording devices;
- Lenses with a total-focal strength of greater than
 200mm are not permitted into the venue;
- To ensure patron privacy is maintained, the use of cameras including mobile telephones with camera interfacing, must not be used in areas such as change rooms and toilets;
- > Shade cover structures;
- > Signs/Banners/Clothing or any other item displaying commercial, political, religious or offensive messages or logos;
- > Signs/Banners/Clothing or other item intended for the engagement of ambush marketing;
- Throwing objects including onto the field of play is prohibited and may result in the patron responsible being evicted (penalties apply);
